Deskrizzjoni	<p>This study unit is designed for complete beginners in Maltese. It helps participants learn to pronounce, read, understand and write basic words, short sentences and the most common Maltese expressions used in everyday language, such as introducing oneself, greeting people, and talking about oneself, one's family, friends and environment. Teaching is set against the Maltese socio-cultural background, so that the course serves as an introduction to both the language and the community that speaks it. Classroom instruction is mixed with visits to public places such as shops, public institutions and historical sites, where participants meet and converse with people in different contexts and situations.</p> <p>The themes treated in this study unit include: personal identity; friends and relatives; towns and cities; the home; the world; the natural habitat; creatures of the earth.</p> <p><i>Din it-taqsim-studju hija maħsuba għal min għadu se jibda jitgħallem l-ilsien Malti. Min jidhol għaliha jitgħallem jgħid, jaqra, jifhem u jikteb il-kliem ewlieni, sentenzi qosra u l-espressjonijiet l-aktar komuni bil-Malti kif ninqadew bihom fil-ħajja ta' kuljum; ngħidu aħna, kif ninroduċu ruħna, insellmu lil xulxin, nagħtu tagħrif dwarna nfuṣna, nitkellmu dwar niesna u fejn noqogħdu. Deskrizzjoni	<p>This study unit is a continuation and reinforcement of MAL1011, while branching out into new areas of language use. Participant practise also reading and writing short texts in Maltese, especially texts one comes across in everyday life. All this is set against the Maltese socio-cultural background. Deskrizzjoni	Towards the end of the course students will be asked to produce an original project in which they will have the opportunity to put together in one work their knowledge both of the Maltese language and of the Maltese environment and way of life. In a typical project a student might write at some length about his/her country, people and mentality comparing and contrasting them to Malta, its people and their mentality. The project will be submitted in written form, but students will also be expected to make a short oral presentation of it to his colleagues and teacher, and to answer their questions. <i>Lejn tmiem il-kors l-istudenti jkun mitluba jipproduċu proġett oriġinali li fih</i>

ikollhom l-opportunità juru f'xogħol wieħed dak li jkunu tgħallmu kemm mil-lingwa Maltija kif ukoll dwar l-ambjent Malti u l-ħajja Maltija. Fi proġett tipiku student jista' jikteb f'tul moderat dwar artu, niesu u l-mentalità tagħhom, u jqabbilhom u jikkontrastahom ma' Malta, niesha u l-kultura tagħha. Il-proġett jinħadem bil-kitba, imma l-istudenti huma mistennija jipprezentawh ukoll fi kliemhom fil-qosor lil sħabhom u 'l-għalliema tagħhom, u jwieġbu l-mistoqsijiet li jagħmlulhom dwaru.
